



Undergraduate Student Exchange / Study Abroad

The University of Macau (UM) promotes student mobility and increases students' international exposure and experience. For this purpose, UM keeps expanding its international networks of student exchange and study abroad programmes with top universities.

Undergraduate Student Exchange

Exchange helps students develop a global perspective by exposing them to different cultures. It also broadens their horizons and knowledge. UM encourages its students to go abroad and also welcomes students from its partner universities to participate in semester or summer/winter exchange. Scholarships are available for both incoming and outgoing students.

Financial arrangement

- Students continue to pay tuition fee at their home university, and the tuition fee of the host university will be waived.
- Students are responsible for their own expenses, including accommodation, transportation, insurance, etc.
- Scholarship of MOP22,000 (1 EURO=9 MOPs) will be provided for one semester.

Undergraduate Student Study Abroad

The Honours College (HC) of UM provides students with intellectual, social and international experience in an enhanced and supportive environment, with the mission to cultivate high achievers and globally competitive leaders who have collaborative skills, creative thinking and a good sense of responsibility. In view of this, study abroad is made an important component of the HC programme. The HC sends its students to a world-renowned university to study full-time in the second semester of their third year.
