Semester Exchange Programme

Semester Exchange Programme provides opportunities to study at UM partner institutions (host institutions) for one or two semesters(s). An exchange student who successfully completed courses at the host institution may transfer credits to UM in accordance to the regulations thereof.

- Eligibility: Undergraduate and postgraduate students
- Tuition fee of the host university is waived.
- Scholarships for undergraduates are available on a competitive basis at an amount of MOP5,000-150,000.

Countries / Regions of the host university	Amount of Scholarship (MOP)
Zone 1: Foreign Countries outside Asia	\$15,000
Zone 2: Foreign Asia Countries	\$10,000
Zone 3: China (Mainland China, Hong Kong SAR and Taiwan region)	\$5,000

















O2 IAESTE Internship Exchange Programme

IAESTE Programme provides paid, courserelated overseas internships for students during summer to get technical experience in the science and engineering disciplines.

- Eligibility: Undergraduate and postgraduate students in FHS, FST and ICMS
- No programme fee is required.
- Students who have successfully completed the entire internship will receive a one-time subsidy/scholarship.



10,000 Talent Programmes

This is a series of programmes provided by higher education institutions in mainland China during summer and winter break, including summer courses, cultural programmes, social activities or academic competitions.

- Eligibility: Undergraduate and postgraduate students (Depends on programme requirement)
- No programme fee is required.



Erasmus+ Programme

Erasmus+ Programme is a non-regular project-based exchange programme hosted by the European higher education institutions. Students enrolled in the Erasmus Programme would go to study abroad for duration of a minimum of 3 months (or 1 academic term) to a maximum of 12 months.

- Eligibility: Undergraduate and postgraduate students and full-time staff
- No programme fee is required.
- Scholarships provided by European Commission are available.
