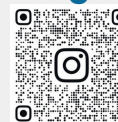

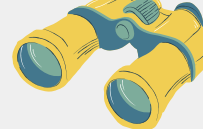

The University of Macau (UM) encourages its students to go abroad, which helps students develop a global perspective by exposing them to different cultures and broadening their horizons and knowledge. For this purpose, UM offers a variety of Student Exchange Programmes to both undergraduate and postgraduate students. Students are responsible for their expenses during the exchange.

OUTBOUND PROGRAMMES



02 Erasmus+ Programme

Erasmus+ Programme is a non-regular project-based exchange programme hosted by European higher education institutions. Students enrolled in the Erasmus Programme would go to study abroad for a minimum of 3 months (or 1 academic term) to a maximum of 12 months.

- Eligibility: Undergraduate and postgraduate students and full-time staff
- No programme fee is required.
- Scholarships provided by the European Commission are available.

03 IAESTE Internship Exchange Programme

The IAESTE Programme provides paid, course-related overseas internships during the summer for students to gain technical experience in the science and engineering disciplines.

- Eligibility: Undergraduate and postgraduate students in FHS, FST, and ICMS
- No programme fee is required.
- Students who have completed the entire internship will receive a one-time subsidy/scholarship.

04 10,000 Talent Programmes

This is a series of programmes provided by higher education institutions in mainland China during summer and winter break, including summer courses, cultural programmes, social activities, and academic competitions.

- Eligibility: Undergraduate and postgraduate students (Depending on program requirements)
- No programme fee is required.

01 Semester Exchange Programme

The Semester Exchange Programme provides opportunities to study at UM partner institutions (host institutions) for one or two semesters(s). An exchange student who completes courses at the host institution may transfer credits to UM in accordance with its regulations.

- Eligibility: Undergraduate and postgraduate students
- The tuition fee of the host university is waived.

The Exchange Ambassador Scheme

This scheme recognizes outbound/study abroad students who serve as UM Exchange Ambassadors. Students who fulfill the mission's requirements can earn a prestigious "UM Exchange Ambassador" certificate and /or a cash award (MOP 5,000 ~ 8,000).

Exchange Ambassadors are required to:

- Actively participate in activities at the Exchange University.
- Share the strengths of UM with local students of the Exchange University.
- Promote UM as an attractive destination for exchange students in the university community.
- Share experiences via social media campaigns.
