





Learning Environment

UM offers around 130 degree programmes covering a variety of fields, and the quality education is globally recognized in various university rankings.

The University organizes a vibrant mix of events, competitions, public lectures, seminars, visits or community services to enrich the students' life on campus. You also have opportunities to interact with our invited speakers and leading scholars.

Our Library is the largest library in Macau, with an area of about 30,000 square meters and a collection of over 12 million pieces or items. The Library provides group discussion rooms as well as silent zone for individual study.

There are nearly 30 sports, cultural, and art teams, as well as about 100 student-led groups under the Students' Union and the Postgraduate Association. You can make friends with students from different cultural backgrounds.

How to Apply?

We only accept nominations from our exchange partners and you should apply through the International Office or Department Office of your home university.

You need to provide the following supporting documents for your application:

- Academic transcript
- Curriculum vitae
- Course selection form
- Recommendation letter

After your application is accepted by UM, you will receive a link for course pre-enrollment and upload the following documents:

- 1.5 inches white background color photo
- Copy of the personal information page of your passport

Scholarship

UM provides scholarship to incoming undergraduate students with valid foreign passports and good academic records to participate in UM credit-bearing semester exchange programmes. Applicants from UM strategic collaboration partners and countries will be prioritized.

Each awardee will receive a fixed amount of MOP15,000 (~USD1,800, ~EUR1,700) after his/her registration at UM. The scholarship is normally delivered in October (for exchange in fall semester) and March (for exchange in spring semester).

Entry Requirements



Visa and Entry Permit

You should enter Hong Kong or Macau with an Entry Visa (Tourist Visa). You might be requested to show your "UM Letter of Acceptance" to the officers at Hong Kong or Macau Immigration Border. This Letter will be sent to you after the confirmation of the corresponding faculty acceptance.

The Macau SAR Government offers visa and entry permit exemption to up to **82 countries**, namely Australia, Brazil, Czech, Italy, Ireland, Japan, Turkey, USA and UK, which allow visitors to stay in Macau for 14 - 90 days.

Countries that are not included in the entry permit exemption list can easily apply for an entry permit at any of the border checkpoints upon arrival at Macau or apply in advance through the Residence and Stay Affairs Department or a diplomatic mission of the People's Republic of China or a representative office.

Stay Permit


The Student Affairs Office will assist all international students with the stay permit application upon arrival.

If you would like to apply for the Study Visa on your own after your arrival, you have to prepare the following documents and go to the Macau Immigration Office for application:

- Original copy of the Travel Documents (e.g. Passport);
- Testimonial issued by the University of Macau:
- Passport Photo (white background, 1.5 inch):
- Original and copy of the latest "Slip of Authorization to Stay (small paper given on arrival)"

Transportation



A weekend getaway to Hong Kong or Mainland China is also an ideal and convenient option.

You can either take the ferry (1h travel) in the Macau-Taipa Ferry Terminal or Macau Outer Harbor Ferry Terminal to Hong Kong. On the other hand, the Golden Bus Shuttle (40 min travel) available at the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macau Bridge is an alternative option, depending on the areas you would like to explore in Hong Kong.

Both locals and non-locals will have to cross the border to go to China, the nearest one to UM is the Hengqing Border, which will lead you to Hengqin. Whereas the Qingmao Border and The Border Gate located in Macau Peninsula side will lead you to Zhuhai.

Macau has a total size of 32.9 sq. kilometers, which made it very accessible to travel throughout the city.

You can simple transit via bus between the University of Macau and the city centre (e.g. COTAI Strip and Ferreira do Amaral Plaza).

To travel between Macau Peninsula and Taipa Island, you can choose to take a bus, taxi or even the latest Light Rapid Transit (LRT). The journey only takes approximately 15 - 20 minutes.
